(B/W) (Ukrainian) (60 min.)

The Black Valley is set in Ukraine in the 17th Century at the  
of the Kozak-Turkish wars. It is the story of the legendary  
Sirko, the last Koshoviy otaman of the Kozak Sich. (color)  
(Ukrainian) (97 min.)
- UKR/16 - DREAM  
Made in the early 1960's by the Dovzhenko Film Studio in Kiev  
this film about the young Taras Schevchenko has rarely been  
shown in Ukraine. Written by Dmytro Pavlychko, and directed  
Volodymyr Denysenko, the movie stars Ivan Mykolaychuk as

Danylo, Prince of Halych is known as one of the great rulers of  
Ukraine. Born in 1238, he was the founder of Lviv and Kholm.  
this film, Danylo is shown fighting the Tartars after the capture

Shadows of Forgotten Ancestors is generally considered a film  
classic. Produced in Kiev's Dovzhenko Studio in 1964 and directed  
by Serhiy Paradzhanov, the film is based on an early 20th century  
novel by Mykhaylo Kotsyubynsky. Set in the rugged Carpathian  
mountains in Ukraine, it is a love story rich in the traditional  
folklore of these mountains. The film was awarded a number of  
international film prizes. This is the full, uncut version of the
